Duke University Hospital System awarded B4Health a contract for open shift management after a six month national RFP and review of numerous potential providers. Since starting with B4Health, Duke began with approximately 500 internal float pool healthcare professionals and has expanded that to over 2,500 professionals. As an organization, Duke has been able to significantly lower per diem agency expenditures on staffing cases, better identify and thus control overtime usage, and increase compliance with our safe scheduling best practice recommendations. The B4Health Open Shift Management Solution is integrated into the Duke internal scheduling platform, API's ActiveStaffer and SAP to auto download and scrub our active list of healthcare professionals. As shifts are booked and confirmed, the system ports filled shifts directly back into our scheduling tool.

The Duke University Hospital system staffing is a large university based system much like the Johns Hopkins Healthcare system and the University of Virginia Hospital system. Our experience with the management team at B4Health has been very impressive. We have continued to expand our service relationship with B4Health and have looked to them to complete most integration work with our internal API products and with SAP. In our last renewal with B4Health, we have included our agency vacancy needs as well a full shift vacancy fulfillment platform in one software program that acts as the agent to share and port data into our other existing software programs.
